RULES

- 1. Posters must be 14" X 22" (This is 1/2 sheet of poster board).
- 2. Posters must be 22" horizontal.

- 3. Copyrighted figures such as Pokemon, Garfield, Snoopy, etc. CAN NOT be used.
- 4. Do not attach anything higher than 1/8-inch to your poster.

On the back of your poster, be sure to write:
