

2026-2027 Eligible Master Courses by TAEF Program

Educational Requirement

Approved applicants are required to have a current eligible master certification at **time of reimbursement** – not at time of application – to be considered for cost share reimbursement.

- Eligible courses are determined by program.
- Certificate must be completed by the approved applicant. No exceptions.
- Certificates must be issued 2023 or after to be accepted.
